How does Flexyfoot work?

The bellows is screwed into the 'collar' for easy fitting and replacement but the special thread also enables the foot to rotate without coming undone. This enables the user to twist and turn whilst being supported by their aid and reduces stress and strain to their wrist and shoulder joints.

Integral seal prevents ingress of dirt and water.

Patented bellows is sealed so that air acts as a spring when the bellows is compressed which cushions shock and impact.



Conventional ferrule traps mud and stones. Flexyfoot's easy to clean tread helps to stay clear of debris making the transition from outside to inside easier and safer. It is also quieter! The bellows allows the 'foot' to automatically adjusts to the angle of the ground or floor, maximising the tread contact area. Grip is therefore greatly improved and wear is greatly reduced.
